Under these five-year programs, students earn a Bachelor of Science (BS) from their home institution, typically in a science or mathematics discipline, and a Master of Engineering (ME) degree from UVA. Students spend their first three years at their home institution completing core requirements. After meeting specific academic criteria, they apply to UVA as non-degree-seeking students to take courses that can be transferred to complete their BS and prepare them for graduate engineering studies at UVA. They subsequently apply for formal admission to UVA's graduate engineering program.
