

UVA Engineering Transfer Guidelines

General Procedure:

UVA Engineering will have two transfer application deadlines per year, in December and March, for Intra-University Transfers. Only students that have completed the Engineering core first year requirements and have continued to make progress toward an engineering degree will be eligible for the December transfer window. Transfer applications will consist ONLY of the UVA Engineering Transfer Application Form completed by the applicant.

Criteria:

You must be in good standing with the University, including a CUM GPA above 2.0, and must NOT be on academic probation/warning (in your home school) at the time of the transfer application.

You must achieve a GPA of at least 2.5 in the “core” engineering courses or equivalent college course which include:

You are highly encouraged to have completed the above "core." If any of these courses are not completed, it is recommended that you make a note in your application of when you plan to take the missing course.

Application Process:

If you are seriously considering transfer to UVA Engineering, you should do the following:

Examine the transfer criteria and ensure that you will have completed the requisite courses (criterion 3) and achieved the requisite grades (criteria 1 and 2) at the time of transfer and create a plan to make progress toward a degree through reviewing degree requirements

If you are a first-year student, consult with the UVA Engineering Director of Undergraduate Success ([Lisa Lampe](#), A-122 Thornton Hall) for advice about the engineering curricula, special programs, and other features of life in SEAS

If you are a second- or third-year student, consult directly with the undergraduate program person in your desired major for advice about the specific major
